

SERVICE TO STUDENTS

- **Literacy Help Line** for students looking for adult literacy programs near home or work (services offered via telephone and online)
- **Project BEST** high school equivalency (HSE) classes at the White Settlement Family Resource Center
- **Math Mastery** classes on Wednesday afternoons in the Atmos Energy Learner Lab
- Literacy Education and Reading Network (**LEARN**) tutoring for low level readers
- Consultation with and **financial assistance** for adult learners preparing for the High School Equivalency Exam
- **English as a Second Language** and **Adult Basic Reading** classes starting onsite spring 2016

SERVICE TO PROVIDERS

- **Fourth Friday Forums** offer free training to literacy volunteers and teachers
- **Metroplex Literacy Conference** held each spring provides 16-20 different workshops for literacy instructors in English Language Acquisition, US Citizenship, High School Equivalency, Financial and Health Literacy, and related topics
- **North Texas Math Literacy Conference** and similar special topics conferences provide training in specific topics to prepare teachers to help their students learn
- **Training and Technical Support** is provided to individual instructors, program directors and interested individuals on a one-to-one basis or in small groups as requested, in order to improve the quality and/or increase the quantity of adult literacy programs
- **Books, computers and classroom supplies** distributed free of charge to literacy programs throughout the year
