



The Literacy Texas Annual Conference is designed to meet the training needs of a broad cross-section of organizations that provide literacy services: small, all-volunteer organizations, larger organizations with numerous paid staff, and community members/ other organizations interested in literacy. If you are involved in literacy as a program administrator, volunteer, board member, or supporter, this conference is for you! Join literacy providers from around the state to discuss current issues and to learn techniques and best practices.

The conference will be held from August 4-5, 2014, at the Embassy Suites Hotel in San Marcos, TX. Keynote speakers this year will be Anson Green, the Director of the Adult Education and Literacy for Texas Workforce Commission, and Nelson Lauver, "a regular guy who just happens to be a master communicator and strategic storyteller," who for nearly three decades was functionally illiterate due to undiagnosed dyslexia.
