## Financial Literacy Month

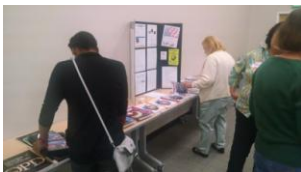
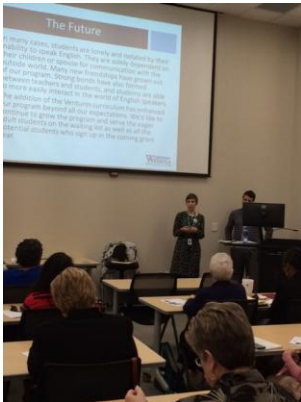
